# HIKING IN 3 DIMENSIONS



The more than 40 round trip tours in our hiking guide are marked in all three dimensions with these colors (blue, red and black). The same colors can also be found in our hiking map and on the hiking info points.

### 3. DIMENSION till 3,000 m ...



Demanding day trips for experienced people with appropriate condition, surefootedness and a head for heights in the southern mountains of the Hohe Tauern.

**Equipment:** Ankle high hiking boots, drinks, snacks, backpack, warm / windproof clothing, rain protection, rescue foil, bandage, mobile phone.

### 2. DIMENSION till 2,300 m



Varied day hikes in the area of the Kitzbüheler Alpen (Pinzgauer grass mountains) and up to above the tree line of the Hohe Tauern. You should already have some hikes in your legs before you start with the tours in the 3<sup>rd</sup> dimension.

**Equipment:** Ankle high hiking boots, drinks, snacks, backpack, rain protection, mobile phone.

### 1. DIMENSION till 1,300 m



Easy hikes along the valley, up to the tree line. The routes take from one hour up to half day. It is an ideal start for your hiking season and to prepare you for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Dimension.

**Equipment:** Light hiking boots, drinking bottle, energy bar.

## TRIP TO THE ARCTIC

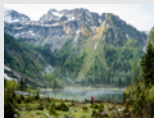

At the end of the tour, you'll reach Schödersee, a special mountain lake referred to as a periodic lake due to its natural underground drainage, which fills only during snowmelt and periods of heavy precipitation.

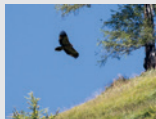

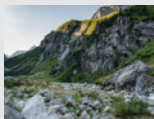


## ADVENTURE HIKE KÄFERTAL

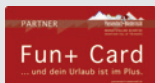

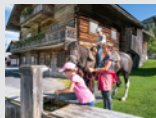

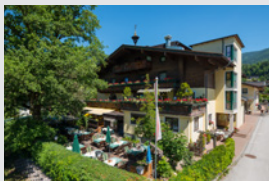
